



Army War College Foundation 2018 Alumni Scholarship Application



The Army War College Foundation Alumni Scholarship program is open to students who are either 1) current high school seniors headed to college in the fall of 2018, or 2) current college undergraduate students in the first three years of study. To apply for all Foundation scholarships (except one), applicants must be the child of an AWC Foundation Life Member. Thanks to the generosity of the Distance Class of 2017, no AWC Foundation membership is required to apply for one scholarship that will be awarded to the top applicant who is a child of a Distance graduate. **The application form and process is the same for all scholarships; each applicant will automatically be considered for all for which eligible.**

Award winners from previous years are not eligible to compete. All valid applications will be evaluated by an impartial committee with no relationship to any of the applicants, and the applications will be evaluated “in the blind” (names removed). The final number and amounts of the Foundation scholarships awarded will be determined after all applications are received and evaluated, but the scholarships will range from \$500 - \$1500. Winners and non-winners will be notified by mail no later than April 30, 2018.

Please send completed scholarship application form and essay to: *Army War College Foundation, 122 Forbes Ave, Carlisle, PA 17013.* An email submission is acceptable (alumni@usawc.org) provided it comes directly from the student’s email account and contains the two required attachments. The subject line of email submissions should be “Scholarship Application.” Transcripts and other attachments (such as award certificates, letters, etc.) will not be considered by the committee; do not include them with your application. Please do not cut and paste this application into a different format. A confirmation email will be sent for all applications received. **NOTE: If you do not receive a confirmation email, please contact the Alumni office (alumni@usawc.org) to confirm receipt.**

Deadline for Application: By midnight, March 2, 2018, EST. (Applications post-marked or emailed after the deadline will not be considered.)

We will make sure your essay is correctly linked to you, but names must be obscured for the “blind” review.

Essay Topic:

Identify a figure from history (no longer living) who you believe could make a difference in solving a major issue that confronts society today. Describe the issue and your rationale as to why that person would be successful tackling that problem.
